Mayors Taskforce for Jobs (MTFJ) is a programme that the Closing The Gaps team deliver within the community of Gore District. It supports employers and job seekers with the goal of placing people in sustainable, full-time paid work for 30+ hours a week.

To maximise your ability to attract and retain staff, Closing the Gaps can provide tailored financial support to develop your capacity to employ young people. Closing the Gaps offers a free service to connect employers with potential employees.



How can we do this?

If you're thinking about employing someone new in your business, you may be able to get financial assistance to achieve this through Closing the Gaps.

Individual employers can access funding to potentially support someone who is:

- a NEET (Not in Education, Employment or Training); or
- · clearly identified as at risk of becoming a NEET; or
- · a disabled youth; or
- · other youth aged 16-24; or
- a person of any age who is disadvantaged in the labour market and are not able to readily access MSD products and services; or
- living with a disability

The programme has the funding capacity to support up to 50 employees placed in sustainable employment by 30 June 2024.
